You are encouraged to study your Bible so you can determine if a Bible lesson is someone's opinion. Sometimes opinions creep into audio, video and printed books and lessons as well as Bible commentaries; also, in the teachings of preachers, ministers, pastors, priests or rabbis. Be careful with dictionary meaning as they change over time and dictionaries provide ancient and current meaning of words and phrases.

Several Greek words may be translated into one word in English and may distort the original meaning. For instance, the Greek words *de* and *kai* were translated as "and" in English. In Greek *De* is used to separate two nouns whereas *kai* connected two nouns.
